Tree stands must be the portable, ladder or stand-alone type; no driving of nails into trees is allowed

Ground blinds and shooting houses are permitted

Do not park in such a way as to block other vehicles and do not block road ways

Do not leave any debris on the property; do not chase deer with dogs

Do not tamper with the farm machinery; abide by all state, county and ODS regulations

Do not exceed 15 mph while on the property
